'inām Literally: reward; a tax-free grant of land *igrār* A legally binding declaration in Islamic law

 $j\bar{a}g\bar{i}r$ Temporary assignment of revenue proceeds of a certain area as salary

jāgīrdār Holder of a jāgīr, usually also a mansabdār

mahzar- Document of testimony

mauza Smallest unit of Mughal tax administration, usually a village
