

Two Asian cricetodontine-like muroid rodents from the Neogene of western North America – CORRIGENDUM

In the published version of this article (Martin et al., 2023), the following errors were present:

- On the eleventh page of the article, the holotype for *Deperetomys dingusi* is described as a partial left mandible. It should say “partial right mandible.”
- Later on the same page, under the subheading “Mandible,” the second sentence reads, “From labial aspect, the anterior and posterior masseteric scars meet in a small anterior masseteric crest (amc) under m1.” This should properly read, “From labial aspect, the dorsal and ventral masseteric crests meet in a small anterior masseteric crest (amc) under m1.”
- In Figure 9.2, the labels “anterior masseteric scar” and “posterior masseteric scar” should read “dorsal masseteric crest” and “ventral masseteric crest,” respectively.
- In the caption of Figure 9, the description of Figure 9.3 is missing the designation “reversed”; it should read “(3) lingual view (reversed).”
