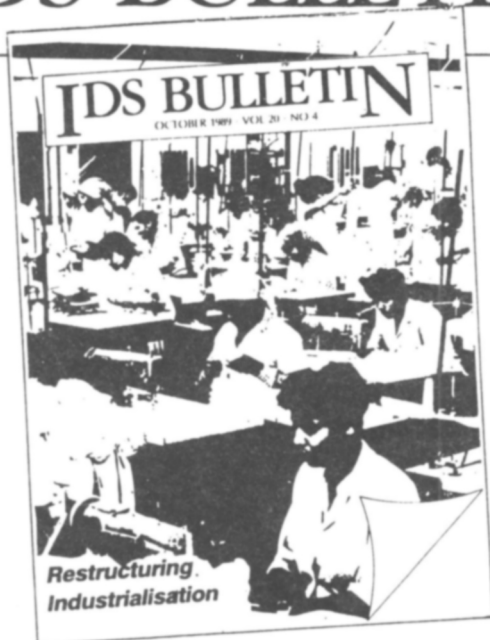


IDS BULLETIN
