

Nowadays there are relatively few people who study a taxonomic group *per se*; many more become interested in the groups through the pursuit of one of the sub-disciplines such as ecology, behaviour, anatomy, physiology, genetics, etc. The journal therefore has an interdisciplinary nature and is intended for a

wide readership, both amateur and professional. Contributions which promote the dissemination of knowledge of mammals or encourage their study are invited, particularly those which describe work in progress in the various disciplines and which help to bridge interdisciplinary gaps. Reports on the status and distribution of mammalian species are also welcomed.

The Publication Board of the Nordic Society Oikos and the Nordic Publishing Board in Science (NOP-N) have decided to make the publication profile of Holarctic Ecology more distinct and at the same time adopt the new name ECOGRAPHY. Up to now Holarctic Ecology has been publishing studies of a kind partly similar to those published in its sister journal OIKOS. From 1992 the content of ECOGRAPHY has a more strongly pronounced profile with emphasis on biodiversity, natural history, biogeography and conservation. ECOGRAPHY is a term sometimes used as synonym for *descriptive ecology*.

We believe this indicates the new profile of the journal, publishing studies on *ecological patterns*.
