held makes it politically important. Secondly Bishop Berkeley's famous prophecy is in process of fulfilment before our eyes. 'The course of empire' has taken its way westwards, but it remains to be seen what will be the dominant idea of that empire. Will it be inspired by 'dollar imperialism' diluted by humanitarianism or by an older and more humane tradition? Can a democracy with an elective monarchy maintain a consecutive and effective foreign policy? Upon the answers to these questions the fate of Europe would appear to rest. Mr Burham's book is a notable contribution to their solution.
