Qualities of covariate and treatment, as determined by the researcher	Pretreatment Measure	Posttreatment measure
<i>i. Covariate is fixed/stable</i>	Risk of priming effects	OK
<i>i. Covariate is susceptible to treatment</i> <i>ii. Covariate cannot contaminate study via priming effects</i>	OK	Risk of posttreatment bias
<i>i. Covariate is not susceptible to treatment</i> <i>ii. Covariate can contaminate study via priming effects</i>	Risk of priming effects	OK
<i>i. Covariate is susceptible to treatment</i> <i>ii. Covariate can contaminate study via priming effects</i>	Risk of priming effects	Risk of posttreatment bias
