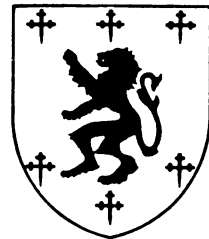

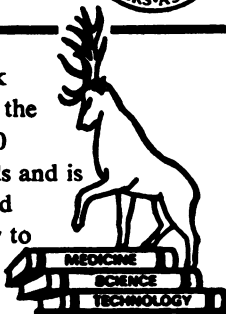

Perspectives on medicine

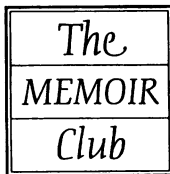
Under its two special imprints the *BMJ* publishes books that reflect the changing face of medical practice and give insights into the personalities and philosophies of some of its practitioners.
