MANUSCRIPT REQUIREMENTS

1. Manuscripts submitted for publication in *Clay Minerals Bulletin* must be an original typewritten copy (not a carbon).

2. The text must be in a concise and readily understandable style. Essential contents to be recapitulated briefly in an abstract to be placed at the beginning of the article. The text must be ready for printing and carefully checked for errors.

3. If possible, two copies of figures are requested, one with and one without any lettered or written material.

4. All figures and tables must have legends, the former below and the latter above.

5. Literature references are to be listed alphabetically, placed at the end of the manuscript and not given as footnotes. The general form to be followed is as follows: Mackenzie, R. C. 1951. *J. Colloid Sci.*, **6**, 219-250. The abbreviations of the *World List* must be followed.

6. To conserve space, authors are requested to mark in pencil less important portions of the paper (such as description of methods, record of experimental results, etc.) for printing in smaller type.
