

## THE KLUWER LATEX STYLE FILE

Kluwer Academic Publishers has developed a special style file for authors who want to submit  $\LaTeX$  articles. KLUWER.STY is a general  $\LaTeX$  style file which is used for all Kluwer journals, irrespective of the publication's size or layout. (The specific journal characteristics are added later during the production process.) Authors are kindly requested always to use KLUWER.STY when creating a  $\LaTeX$  article for a Kluwer journal.

### *Instruction File*

Although KLUWER.STY is very similar to the ARTICLE.STY and uses many of the standard  $\LaTeX$  commands, there are some differences. These are explained in the accompanying instruction file - KAPINS[number].TEX

### Getting the Kluwer Style File

KLUWER.STY is offered at a number of servers around the world. Unfortunately, those are unauthorized copies and authors are strongly advised not to use them. Kluwer can only guarantee the integrity of files obtained directly from Kluwer.

Please send your completed  $\text{\LaTeX}$  article on diskette, together with the appropriate number of hard copies to the address listed in the *Instructions to Authors* of your journal.

#### *Via E-mail*

Experience has shown that sending articles via e-mail can sometimes result in lacunas appearing in the article. That's why Kluwer prefers to receive  $\text{\LaTeX}$  articles on diskettes, accompanied by the hard copies. If you must send the  $\text{\LaTeX}$  article via e-mail, don't forget to send the requisite number of hard copies by air mail.
