*Volume One, Part A* contains principal legal instruments – the so-called ‘classical instruments’ – elaborated within the United Nations, and also includes a chapter on all space law disputes which have arisen up to the present. *Part B* deals with current problems.

*Volume Two, Part A* deals with international organizations, *Part B* with international projects (short technical introductions precede the information about the present legal status in each case), and *Part C* deals with national legislation specifically concerning outer space issues.

Each treaty and convention is followed by the status of each instrument, and each subchapter by a list of related basic legal literature.
