APSA Helps Organize Congressional Briefing

To determine the reality of the perception that Americans have lost interest and trust in government, the Consortium of Social Science Associations (COSSA) sponsored a July 16, congressional briefing entitled "Do Americans Care About and Trust Their Government?" APSA, an active member of COSSA, helped organize the briefing.

John Hibbing of the University of Nebraska, Pippa Norris from Harvard University, and Wendy Rahn, a faculty member at the University of Minnesota, discussed their research on Americans' attitudes towards major governmental institutions, the role of the media, and the political disengagement of young people. Representative David Price (D-NC), a six-term member of Congress who holds a Ph.D. in political science from Yale University, moderated the session.
