

CHRISTMAS GIFTS FOR PRIESTS
A TREATISE ON PREACHING

Humbert of Romans, O.P.

This little classic, by the fifth Master-General of the Dominican Order, is published to fill a very definite need. The majority of modern books on preaching fall rather easily into one of several categories; namely, collections of sermons, suggested outlines for sermons, or the method of writing sermons. This volume is more fundamental; it is concerned with basic principles and, therefore, is in no danger of being outdated or old-fashioned. Humbert treats of the main aspects of preaching, and displays his happy capacity for wedding general principles to minute details. The general tone is lofty with a wealth of quotations from Scripture and the Fathers, and yet the whole is studded with practical suggestions. The present work is an excellent guide to fruitful preaching; may it also serve to enkindle the zeal of those who are chosen not only to offer the *Verbum Dei* on the altar but also to propound the *Verbum Dei* from the pulpit. 12s. 6d.

Canon Leclercq says of preaching: 'An activity which occupies so important a place in the life of the clergy deserves study of the works which it produces.' This book seeks to provide the clergy with such a study. The author considers precisely what preaching can and should accomplish, the sources from which the preacher should draw his matter, the nature of the *mission* to preach, and the qualifications the Church demands and those it desires in the preacher. The Blessed Sacrament and the Mass

ST THOMAS AQUINAS

This book is an attempt to put in a brief compass St Thomas's teaching on the Holy Eucharist, and to make him more easily understood by those who are reading him for the first time. No one wrote with such accuracy and fulness of Christ and his Sacraments as did St Thomas. He wrote some three hundred years before the 'Reformation' and thus had no prejudice against the new teaching of the Reformers. In this book will be found both what Christians really believed before Christendom was disrupted and what Catholics the world over believe today. 10s. 6d.

The Christian Vision

The first numbers of *The Life of the Spirit* appeared in 1945 as supplements to *Blackfriars*. FRANCIS EDWARD NUGENT

This is a good anthology, offering something from the varied types of work to which Father Vincent turned his hand. Those who do not know him as an author will find here a cross-section of his great output sufficient to whet their appetite for more. The editor notes in his introduction that this anthology is in a sense autobiographical. The reader will find as he progresses that he cannot help forming a picture of the saintly and gifted man who was Father Vincent. 13s. 6d.

Forward the Layman

J. M. PERRIN, O.P.

This is a book that every layman ought to read, for the author shows that it is the laity who are the Church, and it is for them to bring about the coming of the Kingdom of God by active and intelligent co-operation with the clergy. Here is discussed in detail both the inner and outward life of the lay person, whether he is working close to the Church in unison with the clergy, whether he is working at social betterment or whether he is going as the Church's spearhead into places where the Church at present cannot penetrate, and shows how the life of even the humblest and most miserable person is of priceless value. The author makes it quite clear that Catholic Action is not a bustling activity of organisation, although it might take that form, but a force bringing us close to our Lord in mystical union. 14s. 6d.
