EDITORIAL

WHEN the *Journal of Laryngology and Otology* was purchased by the present Company twelve years ago, and it was fortunate enough to secure the services of Dr. Logan Turner as its Editor, it was felt that it would be advisable to have the actual publishing undertaken in Scotland, as by this means fuller and easier co-operation between the Editor and the Publishers could be assured. It was accordingly decided to ask the well-known house of Oliver & Boyd, Edinburgh, to undertake the work. We think that everyone will agree that they have done the work entrusted to them extremely well and that the production of the *Journal*, both as regards its paper, type and illustrations, leaves little to be desired.

Unfortunately, since the Editorial centre was removed to London some years ago, it has been found increasingly difficult to carry on the arrangement of having the *Journal* published in Scotland, and it is with some reluctance that the Directors of the Company have felt themselves compelled to transfer the printing to a London firm. We are convinced that no loss of efficiency will result and every endeavour will be made that the technical conduct of the *Journal* will be carried on in the accustomed way.

In conclusion we would like to thank Oliver & Boyd most heartily for all that they have done for us in the past and to give a most sincere welcome to Headley Brothers, who are to be our publishers in the future.
