# The German Fifth Column in the Second World War

#### By louis de jong

Shortly after Hitler came to power, a rumor spread that the Nazis had created a vast network of espionage and conspiracy. Early Nazi successes in Austria and Czechoslovakia lent credence to this fear, and the later incredibly swift conquests of Poland, Denmark, Norway, France, and the Low Countries seemed to confirm it. But Louis De Jong shows that the facts were radically different as he sets forth the whole story of fifth-column panic and examines the reality behind it. There were only two groups comparable to the fifth column that terrified whole nations, he reveals. These groups, in Poland and Yugoslavia, did their work with deadly efficiency, but their existence only serves to highlight Mr. De Jong's major thesis: the world-wide fifth column of popular belief was an exaggerated, grossly overrated ogre.
