This study, first published in 1938 at the request of the Government of Bechuanaland, has been out of print for some years. In response to numerous orders and inquiries the International African Institute has now undertaken the publication of a second edition.

Professor Schapera has written a new introduction reviewing recent developments in the administration of justice by tribal courts in Bechuanaland; the genealogies of chiefly families and the lists of age regiments have been revised and brought up to date. A select bibliography has also been added.

The book, which is the result of the author's own field researches, was one of the first systematic studies of African customary law and native court procedure. It remains a classical exposition of this important aspect of African social organization.
