## Contributors

MARIO AGUILAR is a lecturer in the Department of Social Anthropology, University of St. Andrews, after completing his Ph.D. at the School of Oriental and African Studies in 1994. He has two books in press, *Social and Religious Outcasts in Africa* and *Dios en Africa: elementos para una antropología de la religión*; in 1993 he co-authored (with Laurel Birch de Aguilar) *Women's Organizing Abilities: two case studies in Kenya and Malawi*.

J. ANTHONY ALLAN is Professor of Geography at the School of Oriental and African Studies, University of London. He specialises in the monitoring and evaluation of renewable natural resources in Africa and the Middle East. He has recently published *The Nile: sharing a scarce resource*.

LESLIE BANK is an anthropologist at the Institute of Social and Economic Research, Rhodes University, Grahamstown. He is working on a restudy of Philip and Iona Mayers's urban ethnography *Townsmen and Tribesmen*. He has been writing on Qwaqwa since 1983.

SUZETTE HEALD is a senior lecturer in the Department of Sociology, University of Lancaster. She worked among the Gisu of Uganda in the 1960s and for the last ten years has been doing fieldwork among the Kuria of Kenya. Her book, *Controlling Anger: the sociology of Gisu violence* was published in 1989; in 1994 she co-edited *Anthropology and Psychoanalysis: an encounter through culture*.

HUGH MACMILLAN has been teaching history at the University of Zambia for the last eighteen years; he is shortly to move to the University of the Transkei. He co-edited (with Shula Marks) *Africa and Empire: W. M. Macmillan, historian and social critic*, and has contributed to several books, including Leroy Vail's *The Creation of Tribalism in Southern Africa*.

MELISSA PARKER is an anthropologist at Goldsmith's College, London, and St Mary's Hospital Medical School. In 1989 she completed her thesis for the University of Oxford on the effects of *Schistosoma mansoni* on the health of women in the Gezira province of the Sudan.

SUSAN RASMUSSEN teaches in the Department of Anthropology, University of Houston. Since 1974 she has spent over seven years in Niger as teacher and researcher. In 1995 she published a monograph, *Spirit Possession and Personhood among the Kel Ewey Tuareg*.
