White-Smith, Mrs Hosegood, and Mr Farrand as passengers Mr W H Sear, of Westland Aircraft, arrived in a Widgeon, with Mr Wheeldon and Mr and Mrs Hollis Williams as passengers British European Airways were represented by an S 55 flown by Capt R W Dibb, bringing Capt and Mrs James, and Capt and Mrs Cameron Messrs Saunders-Roe sent a Skeeter The Army Air Corps were represented by Lt-Col J F T Scott, Major Parker, Capt Cullens, Capt Whitehead and Capt Child, in an Alouette and three Skeeters The Joint Experimental Helicopter Unit sent a Whirlwind and a Sycamore, carrying F/Lt Russell, Major Bandy, Capt Truble, F/Lt Clarke, Capt Richardson, and Capt Tippen
