Meditations & Instructions on the Blessed Virgin

By **Rev. A. VERMEERSCH, S.J.**

In this two-volume work one of the foremost theologians of the twentieth century gives to clergy and laity alike a solid treatise on Mariology. Its devotional tone will do much to develop love for Mary, stimulate piety toward her and instill confidence in her.

Volume I is divided into two parts: **FEASTS OF MARY**, meditations on the feasts of the Blessed Virgin, preceded by a short introduction on the origin and the meaning of each one; **MONTH OF MARY**, an examination of the earthly life of the Mother of God and of men as related in the Gospels.

Volume II is also divided into two parts: **MEDITATIONS FOR THE SATURDAYS OF THE YEAR**, a study of the predestination of Mary from God's first choice of her to the glory she now enjoys in heaven; **SUPPLEMENTARY PART**, meditations for movable feasts which may occur during the month of May.

Priests will find here a rich mine of material for sermons, and the faithful who practise the devotion of the five First Saturdays will discover abundant matter for meditation. 56/- per set, 2 vols.

There has long been a need for this small book, telling simply what the Catholic may believe about the Blessed Virgin. It sets forth simply and positively the life of the Blessed Mother, amplifying the gospel story only by the interpretations which the Church seems to favour in her liturgy, in her papal pronouncements, and in her recognized commentators. All apocrypha and revelations of the mystics are rigorously excluded.
