

- (4) that any additional matter should be consonant with the provisions and the spirit of the Antarctic Treaty; and
- (5) that the denomination of the stamp should remain at the discretion of each issuing country.

Stamps have so far been issued in 1971 by Australian Antarctic Territory (23 June), Belgium (19 June), British Antarctic Territory (23 June), Japan (23 June), New Zealand (9 June), Norway (23 June), Republic of South Africa (22 May), USSR (21 June), USA (23 June) and France.
