**FROM THE  
EDITORIAL  
OFFICE**

This past year the Journal received 234 papers, with an acceptance rate of 6.7%. The number of submissions is down from the past three years, which respectively brought 306, 298 and 350 papers into the Editorial Office. Given this volume of papers the Board has decided to include in its instructions to authors the notice that the Journal will normally consider papers of no longer than 10,000 words. Lengthy submissions may be returned to authors with a suggestion to shorten them. Although the Journal continues to send as many papers as possible to two referees, and to use as many different qualified referees as possible, we are facing continuing limitations in this regard. All papers receive blind editorial review, but not all are sent to external referees. The Journal endeavours to inform authors of decisions regarding their submissions within three months if the submission is not sent to external referees and within six months if it is. Whenever possible, comments are sent to authors. The Journal remains committed to the principle of blind, independent and expert review.

Lorne Falkenstein has stepped down from the Editorial Board, as has our longtime CN editor, Cheryl Misak. The board thanks both for their years of service and active involvement with the Journal. Emily Carson has joined the board, and Bruce Hunter has become CN editor.

Almost all authors are now submitting their papers electronically. This enables us to process papers more quickly, within the constraints mentioned above. Papers should be sent to Marda Schindeler, the Journal's Executive Secretary, at [cjp@uleth.ca](mailto:cjp@uleth.ca), in either Word or WordPerfect, and formatted according to the Journal's directions for authors.
