2. and Research Institute under the direction of Professor Joseph Miller. The value of the Fellowship will be £12,500.

4. An Otolological Research Fellowship to work in the Coleman/Epstein Laboratory at the **University of California, San Francisco**, for 6 months during 1997. This Fellowship will offer the holder exposure to ear surgery including cochlear implantation under the direction of Professor Michael Merzenich, with the opportunity of attending grand rounds and meetings in the Department of Otolaryngology. The value of this fellowship is £12,500.

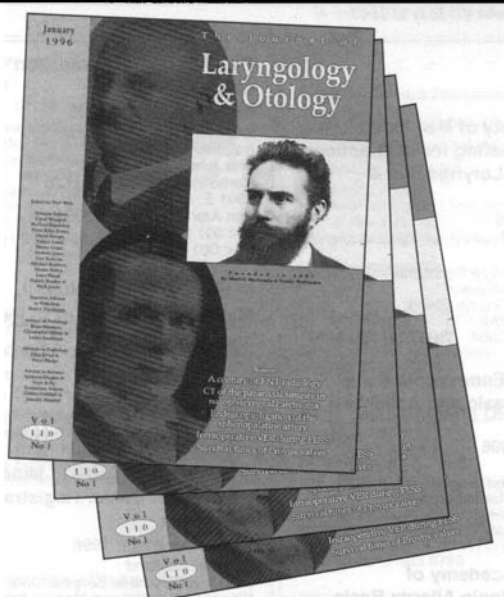

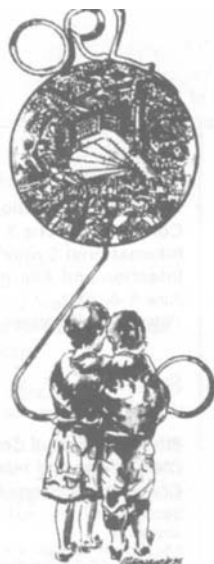
