Rarities in a Museum

The authors have compiled a list of specimens of endangered and recently extinct mammals in the outstanding collections of the Royal Albert Memorial Museum, Exeter. All those listed are in the IUCN Red Data Book except the extinct quagga, koala (recently endangered but now greatly increased and well protected), diademed sifaka, rufous rat-kangaroo and Astor and Kashmir markhors.

The natural history collections of the Royal Albert Memorial Museum. Exeter, were established in 1869 during the curatorship of the eminent Devonshire naturalist, W. S. M. D'Urban. Continual additions since then have made the mammal collection one of the finest in the country, and the bird study skin collection ranks third in size outside the national museums (Stansfield 1965). The size and scope of the mammal collection is largely due to C. A. V. Peel's collections (mainly of mounted big game) presented in 1919 and 1932. Little seems to have been published on these remarkable collections, apart from Lowe (1939) who described the bird collections as a 'find'. In order to document the material and record the location of the specimens of mammals which are extremely rare or recently extinct, we carried out a survey of the museum's displayed and reference collection and compiled this list of the species included in the Red Data Book of the IUCN. The scientific names are those used in Ellerman & Morrison-Scott's Checklist of Palaearctic and Indian Mammals, London, 1951.
