LORD KELVIN AND THE AGE OF THE EARTH

Joe D. Burchfield

Between 1860 and 1930 the question of the earth's age was the subject of heated debate and stimulated important studies in physics, geology, astronomy and biology. One of the prime movers in the search for the earth's age was William Thomson, (1824-1907) later to become Lord Kelvin.

The author has here traced the evolution of the concept of geological time from its emergence as a subject for quantitative determination through the development of procedures for radioactive dating. He has focused on the conflicts which the search for the earth's age caused between the various branches of science, for example between physics and geology, in which Lord Kelvin was more often than not involved.
