INTERNATIONAL PALAEOONTOLOGICAL UNION

The International Palaeontological Union has hitherto functioned as a department of the International Geological Congresses, but at the 1956 Congress in Mexico it was decided to extend its activities, and it is now proposed to publish a Directory to the Palaeontologists of the World. The expanding interests of the Union have necessitated arranging a meeting previous to the next Geological Congress, planned for 1960 in Copenhagen, and the President of the Union (Dr. Maldonado-Koerdell, Mexico City) has decided to call a meeting to coincide with the XVth International Congress of Zoology, and the preceding Colloquium on Zoological Nomenclature, to be held in London during the period 9th to 23rd July. During this session the Union will discuss and adopt a revised Constitution, as modified from that first put forward in 1956 at Mexico.
