# *Power and Leadership in Pluralist Systems*

ANDREW S. McFARLAND

This is a work of empirical political theory: a critique and synthesis of previous research and theory on the nature of power in pluralist systems like that of the United States. After defining power as "intended social causation," the author examines simple causation (elitist systems) and complex causation (pluralist systems). He shows that complexity in this sense may be spurious, and that one cannot prove the existence of democracy simply by demonstrating a dispersal of power. The book concludes with two chapters on the nature of leadership and its place in a pluralist system. \$7.50

# *Education and the State in Tsarist Russia*

PATRICK L. ALSTON

This book examines official, professional, and public efforts to balance off the state's need for disciplined intelligence against society's demand for enlarged opportunities. Unless the central government abandoned its hostility toward public initiative Russia might remain incapable of meeting the challenges offered by her international rivals. But every gesture toward educational reform led to political and social demands that were unacceptable to the security-conscious state bureaucracy. The emphasis is on the period after 1860, when student nihilism became a permanent feature of the educational scene. \$8.50
