Contestatory Photographs, Contested Usages—Through its use in colonial contexts, photography in Africa has been an instrument of scientific commodification, population and identity control as well as a means of coercion through images. What is photography's role today in acts of protest, resistance and emancipation? Half-torn, effaced, barely legible, figures from the past re-emerge through retouched, recomposed images, staged and mobilized for stuggles in the present tense. This issue takes account of the extraordinary malleability of photographic materials. In this digital age, a growing need to re-appropriate historic images is expressed through multiple forms of re-circulation, re-use, and transformation, often in contradiction with the intentions of their original producers.

The Pitfalls of African Statistics

To understand African countries' economic performance, internation institutions and most economists focus their attention on growth statistics, particularly GDP, Norwegian economic historian Morten Jerven sparked much discussion with Poor Numbers (2013), arguing that most of these statistics are arbitrary or distorted. Yet the most prominent analysts still rely on these shaky foundations to discuss the performance of African economies and to make predictions. Without challenging Jerven's conclusions, several economists and economic historians working in the Francophone world have questioned how they should be interpreted. The statistics are wrong, but could it be otherwise? Can we really expect national statistics to reflect reality, particularly in developing countries? Isn't it equally interesting to use sociological or ethnographic methods to examine how these statistics are compiled and to draw lessons about the workings of the countries in question and the international institutions they are accountable to?

Recommendations for authors

The *Annales* only accept original and previously unpublished work, which can be submitted in French or English as well as Italian, German, or Spanish. All manuscripts are assessed by the editorial board within six months of reception and are also sent to two external specialists for peer review. The board can decide to accept a manuscript as it stands or subject to revision. They may also ask for a more substantially modified version that will pass through the evaluation process a second time, or refuse the article directly.

Manuscripts should be sent to the address annales@ehess.fr in a format such as Word or Open Office (and not as a PDF). They must be accompanied by a title and an abstract of around 1,500 characters in both French and English. Maps, graphs, or figures should be submitted as separate files, in high definition and a size suitable to the format of the journal (170 mm \times 240 mm). They must be accompanied by titles, captions, and a note of their sources. Authors are asked to specify their institutional affiliation and their nationality.

The text must be double spaced and follow the recommendations set out on the site http://annales.ehess.fr/index.php?179. It must not exceed 90,000 characters (including notes and spaces), and footnotes are limited to 100. Citations in foreign or ancient languages must be translated into either French or English, depending on the language of the article, with the original included in a footnote if necessary.

Please note that all accepted articles will be published in both French and English, in print and online. Authors will be put in contact with translators and are encouraged to work with our editors to establish high quality academic translations.

To this end, authors of accepted articles will be asked to furnish the original French or English citations from works first published in either language, or to provide references to canonical translations where they exist. They commit to providing a document indicating these alternative citations and references, as well as any necessary changes to proper nouns, etc., and their preferred translations of specific concepts or terminology used.
