(Chairman : The Earl of Scarbrough)

After examining the facilities offered by Universities and other educational Institutions in Great Britain the Commission reached the conclusion that the present provision for the study of these civilizations and languages is "unworthy of our country and people". The recommendations call for a definite lead and greater financial support from H.M. Government.

Regional surveys covering the problems peculiar to the various fields of study are given as an appendix to the Report.
