




In an interesting and insightful article Dr Cliff Wright gives his impression on his recent visit to China with a group of academics.

- References should be referred to in the text by giving, in brackets, the surname of the author and should be listed in numerical order at the end of the ar-

Books: Author's name and initials; year of publication (in brackets); title of book underlined; publisher; page reference, if appropriate.

Articles: Author's name and initials; date of publication (in brackets); title of article; abbreviated title of journal underlined; volume and number.

- Footnotes should be kept of a minimum.
