Prophet of the Counter-Revolution, by LAWRENCE L. BONGIE. Before 1789 there was nothing in the annals of modern Europe of such political importance as the Great Rebellion of seventeenth-century England. At a time when the French nation was itself preparing an event which was to be similar but even more striking, the critical task of interpreting the English Revolution to the French fell principally to the widely-read and wildly-applauded *Tacite des Anglais*, the philosopher-historian David Hume. Professor Bongie studies in this work various *ancien-régime* reactions to Hume's historical writings and examines informally the significant role played by English civil-war history in the formulation of French revolutionary and counter-revolutionary thought. \$5.95
