The Man and the Hip

This biography tells the story of the brilliant orthopaedic surgeon Professor Sir John Charnley, one of Manchester's most famous sons. Charnley made an outstanding contribution to the development of total hip replacement. The book is to some extent the story of this operation, but it is described in relation to his life and does not attempt a scientific evaluation of his work. He created the Centre for Hip Surgery at Wrightington Hospital, which although dedicated to research, was primarily a surgical clinic geared to handling large numbers of patients. This made is possible for him to establish the results of his operation on a scale which had never been achieved before. The way in which Charnley overcame numerous difficulties is a tribute to his single-minded determination.

The survey of world mortality in this book is much more comprehensive than other volumes which usually consider only therapeutic and hygienic factors. The statistical data on diseases are also given in terms of geography, history, economics, demographics, and medicine. An extensive bibliography facilitates use of the book for research purposes. Throughout the book the author focuses on the reasons why mortality has declined, especially since the late nineteenth century. Care is taken to combat current theories which overrate the effectiveness of medical therapy. Insight is given into many neglected aspects of causation and the interaction of non-medical with the better-known medical factors.
