TO THOSE WISHING TO SUBMIT MANUSCRIPTS

Manuscripts for consideration should be submitted in four double-spaced typed copies. (If computer generated, they should be letter quality or near letter quality. Continuous form sheets must be separated.) Notes and block quotations should be double-spaced; notes should be placed at the end of the manuscript and not at the bottoms of pages. Library of Congress transliteration for quotations for fewer than 50 words and the *Chicago Manual of Style* are to be followed. In general, articles should not exceed 25 typed pages $8\frac{1}{2}$ by 11 in dimension—including endnotes.

Manuscripts are sent to outside readers in anonymous form and should be prepared accordingly.

The policy of *Slavic Review* is not to consider materials that have been published or that are being considered for publication elsewhere.

Publication of articles in *Slavic Review* is ordinarily limited to those submitted by members of AAASS. Nonmembers wishing to submit manuscripts will be sent a membership application; please see the inside front cover for information on membership.




