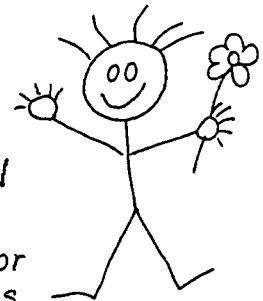
TEACHER TO TEACHER
