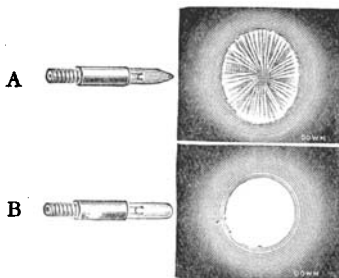

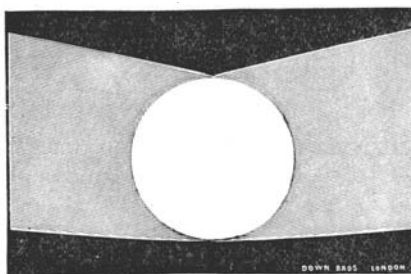
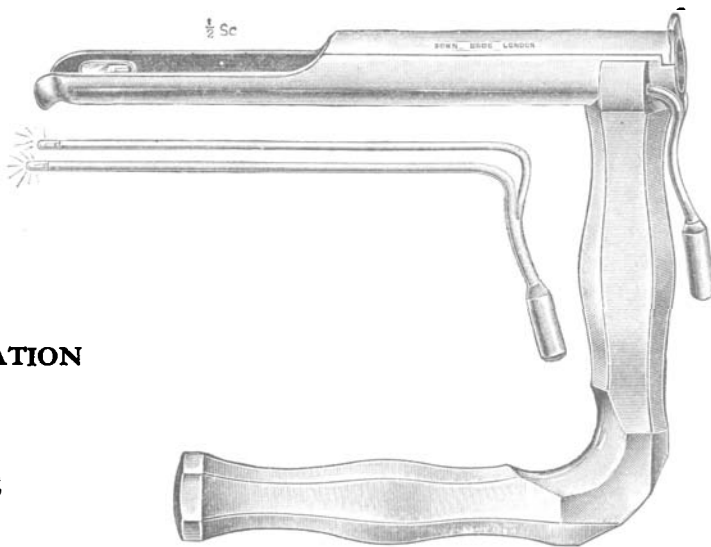
**DOWN BROS.'

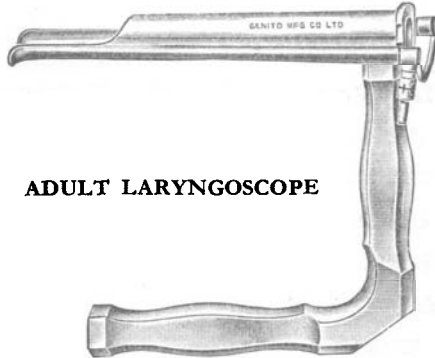
