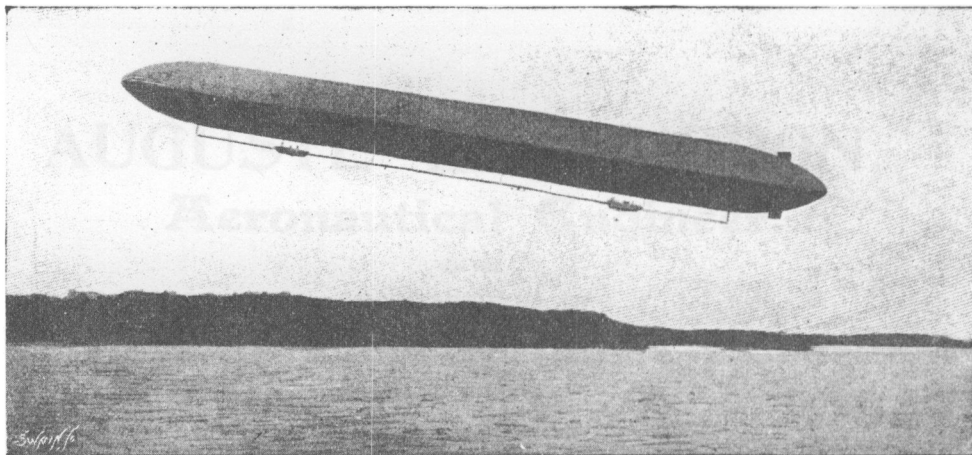

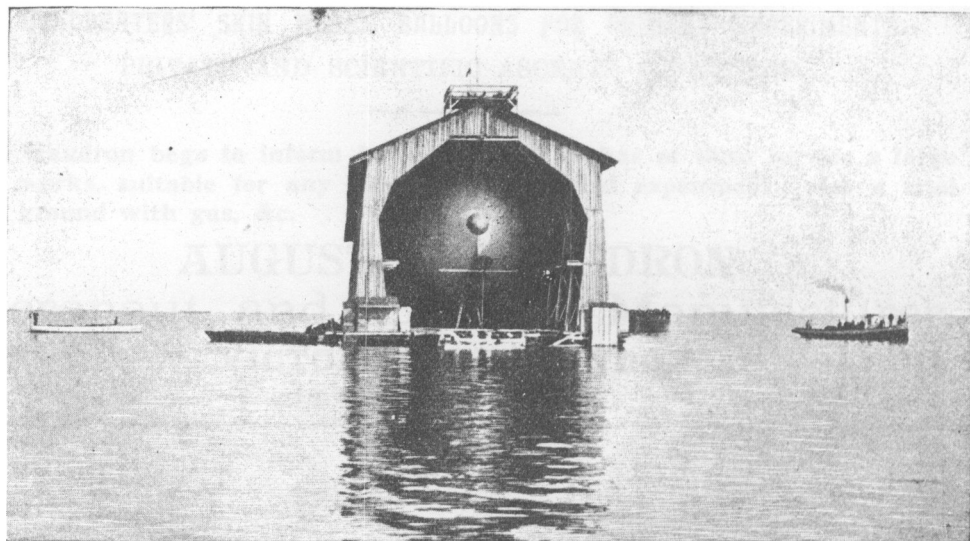

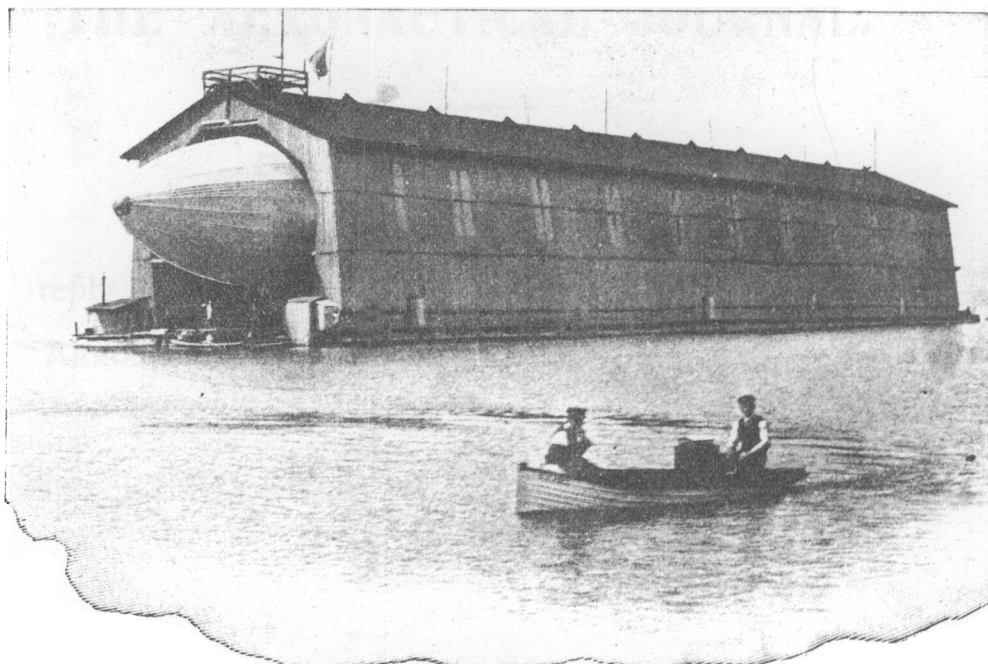
THE ZEPPELIN AIR-SHIP.
