Jean-Louis Miège, *Indentured Labour in the Indian Ocean and the Particular Case of Mauritius*

provides the reader not only with an overview of the 19th century labour market on Mauritius, but also with a wide ranging survey of the consequences of indentured labour in the Indian Ocean.

Prof. Miège provides ample statistical evidence about the very beginning of the migration of indentured labourers, their recruitment, shipping, and wages. Additional information is provided about slave labour and free labour, which occurred simultaneously on Mauritius and La Réunion. The notes, bibliography and list of sources contain much unpublished material, such as the many M.A.- and Ph.D.-theses of the University of Aix-en-Provence.
