Andreas Vesalius of Brussels, 1514–1564

C. D. O'MALLEY

A definitive biography of Vesalius, making full use of the information which has accumulated since Roth's work of 1892. The book gives a detailed account of Vesalius' early studies in anatomy, his writings and his later life. Dr O'Malley assesses the value of Vesalius' work and compares his achievements with those of his forerunners and contemporaries. British Anatomy, 1525–1800

K. F. RUSSELL

A finely printed bibliography of all books on human anatomy by British authors published between 1525 and 1800, together with books by other European anatomists which were translated into English or published in Britain in that period. More than 900 items are listed, and wherever possible a description is given of the original manuscript of the printed book and of manuscripts closely related to the text. E. G. BROWNE

These four lectures sketch the ideas and achievements of Arabian medicine from the eighth to the thirteenth centuries. Professor Browne speaks with rare authority on these matters; he was both a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and Professor of Arabic in the University of Cambridge.
