All typewritten material should be double-spaced, including footnotes and quotations; photocopies of a good quality are acceptable. *The Review* follows the *Chicago Manual of Style* for standards of footnoting, punctuation and other editorial considerations. The normal length of manuscripts published is 25-30 pages. Longer manuscripts will be evaluated in terms of their significance in relation to the limited printing space available.
