REPORT OF THE COUNCIL.

SESSION 1882-3.

THE Council have much pleasure in presenting to the General Meeting of the Fellows their Annual Report of the past Session, from which it will be seen that the Society has made considerable progress in its membership as well as in its financial position.

The Papers read at the Monthly Meetings were :

The Council have begun a new series of Transactions in quarterly parts ; but they propose to give Fellows of the Society the option of having them in the old form of an Annual Volume.

The Council recommend that, with the view of making a gradual increase in the receipts of the Society, the following addition be made to Rule XVII., which regulates the subscription :

"All Members elected after the 1st of March, 1884, shall pay an Annual Subscription of Two Guineas, without an Entrance Fee."

Since the 1st of November last 47 new Fellows have been elected, 6 have died, and 30 have resigned. The following list shows the number of Fellows on the Roll :

During the Session the following Honorary Fellows of the Society died : William Farr, M.D., and the Rev. Robert Moffat, D.D. ; and the following Ordinary Fellows : Rev. Prebendary Jervis, J. Murton, G. W. Digby, H. Schwartz, Hon. George Washington Warren, and R. Yates.

It is with great satisfaction that the Council draw the attention of the Fellows to the financial condition of the Society. During the Session the actual amount of money received by the Treasurer, without taking into account the balance from 1882, was £,430. 10s. 3d. The liabilities incurred during the Session amounted to £336. 16s. 10d., leaving a balance in favour of the year's working of £93. 13s. 5d.

The Council append the Treasurer's receipts and payments from the date of the last account on the 31st of October, 1882, to the end of the present financial year ending on the 31st of October, 1883, and also the Capital Account.

The Auditors appointed to examine the Society's accounts report :

That they have compared the entries in the books with the vouchers from November 1, 1882, to October 31, 1883, and find them correct, showing the receipts, including a balance of £188. 2s. 1d. from 1882, to have been £618. 12s. 4d., and the payments

£596 17s. 10d., leaving a balance in the hands of the Treasurer on October 31, 1883, of £21. 4s. 6d.

There has also been laid before them the Secretary's estimate of the Assets and Liabilities of the Society, the former amounting to £76. 17s. 6d., and the latter to £13. 17s., leaving a balance in favour of the Society of £63. 0s. 6d., as against an estimated balance of £15. 14s. 7d. on October 31, 1882. They find further, that on November 1, 1882, the number of Fellows on the Roll, in accordance with the Report, was 604, and that this number was diminished in the course of the year to the extent of 36 by deaths and resignations, and increased by the election of 47 new Fellows, leaving on the Roll on October 31, 1883, 614 Fellows.
