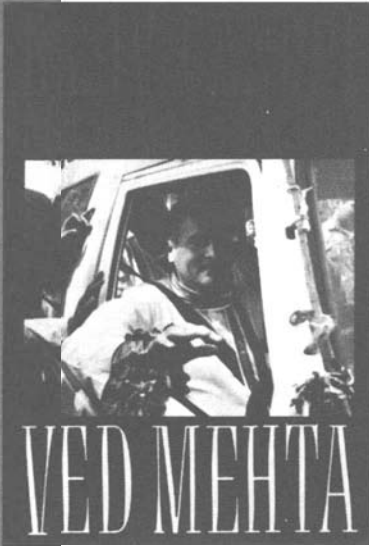

Drawing on interviews and unpublished private and government documents, Barnett Rubin shows how both the communist regime and the mujahidin recruited leaders and mobilised resources for the conflict, and how international changes—from the election of Ronald Reagan to the collapse of the Soviet Union—affected the Afghan state.
