Reliance on a faulty memory led me to telescope two incidents into one. Don Fernando de Silva was killed in an affray with some Japanese and Siamese after leaving Macao in 1624. His death and the seizure of his ship, was avenged by Don Juan de Alcaraso who forcibly seized a Japanese Goshuinsen, or Tokugawa government-licensed ship, in May, 1628. This seizure led to the embargo placed on Portuguese trade at Nagasaki in 1628–1630. *Ibidem*, p. 153, n. 1.
