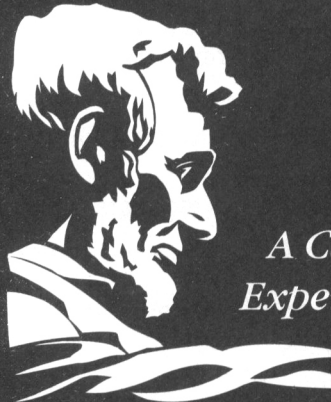

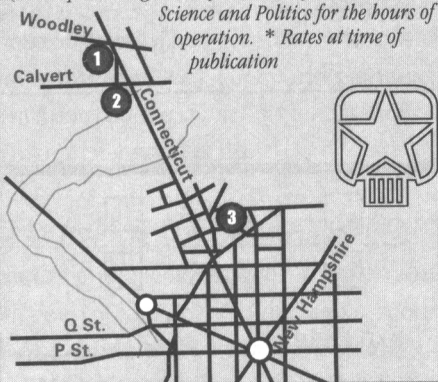

### GENERAL HOTEL INFORMATION

The APSA Housing Bureau will be staffed by the Washington Convention and Visitors Association (WCVA). All requests for rooms will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. It is recommended that you make your hotel reservation requests early to obtain accommodations. All reservation requests must be processed through the APSA/WCVA Housing Bureau. Hotels will not accept reservations directly.

*Have the following information ready when making a reservation:*

1. Name of convention
2. Complete contact information
3. Membership status (You must be a current member of APSA to receive discounted room rates.)
4. 1st, 2nd and 3rd choices of hotels
5. Arrival and departure dates
6. Type of room – single (1 person), double (2 people)
7. Names of ALL occupants of room(s)
8. Name as it appears on the credit card, type of card, number, and expiration date (for credit card deposit)

*Note: If you have any disabilities that require special facilities in your sleeping room, please let the agent know at the time you make your reservation.*

### DEPOSIT

A \$125 (\$250 for one bedroom suite, \$375 for two bedroom suite) deposit is required for all reservations. The deposit amount is payable by credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Diners Club, Discover) and will be applied to your hotel account when you check in. Your credit card will be charged immediately. If your first choice of hotel is not available, your deposit will be applied to the next available hotel. **Reservations will not be processed without payment.** Wire transfers will not be accepted.

### CONFIRMATION

You will receive your hotel confirmation directly from the APSA/WCVA Housing Bureau. Your confirmation will arrive as an email if you make your reservation online. Faxed or mailed confirmations may also be requested if appropriate information is provided.

### CHANGES

**Changes made on or before August 4, 2000** should be made directly with the APSA/WCVA Housing Bureau. After this date, all changes must be made directly with the hotel.

### CANCELLATIONS

**Cancellations made by 6:00pm EST on or before August 4, 2000** should be made with the APSA/WCVA Housing Bureau and will be refunded in full. The APSA/WCVA Housing Bureau will issue the refund. **Cancellations made after 6:00pm EST August 4, 2000 and prior to 72 hours of arrival** must be made with the hotel. A \$16 administrative fee will be deducted from your deposit and the hotel will issue the refund. **Your reservation must be canceled 72 hours prior to arrival or your entire deposit will be forfeit.**

### RATES

**You must be an APSA member to obtain discounted room rates at the hotels.** If you would like member rates and are not currently an APSA member, submit your membership application to APSA concurrently as you secure your room reservation with the APSA/WCVA Housing Bureau.

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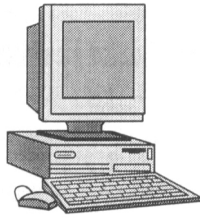
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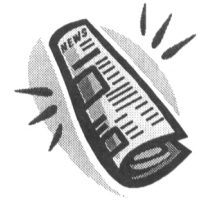
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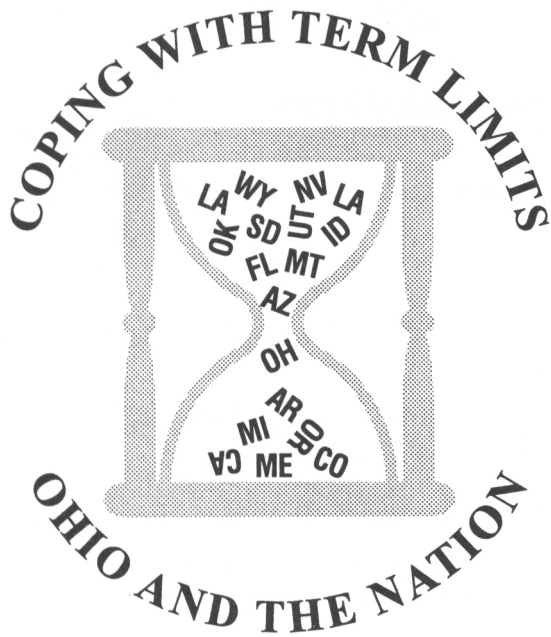
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
