

## Information for Authors

The purpose of the *Canadian Journal of Philosophy* is the publication in Canada of philosophical work of high quality, in English or French, and in any field of philosophy. All submissions are given blind editorial review; those of departmental colleagues are externally refereed.

Manuscripts should be sent in triplicate to: Executive Secretary, *Canadian Journal of Philosophy*, Department of Philosophy, University of Lethbridge, Lethbridge, Alberta, Canada T1K 3M4. It is preferred that manuscripts be typed double-spaced, including quotes and footnotes. In general, the *Canadian Journal of Philosophy* follows *The University of Chicago Manual of Style*. Footnotes should be numbered consecutively and assembled on separate pages at the end of the manuscript. Manuscripts will not be returned unless return postage is prepaid by cheque, money-order, reply coupons, or Canadian stamps.

Authors will receive, without charge, 25 copies of their articles. Additional offprints may be ordered when the proofs are returned to the publisher.

The articles in *C.J.P.* are indexed in *The Philosophers' Index*, Bowling Green, Ohio, U.S.A., in the *Repertoire bibliographique de la philosophie*, Louvain, Belgium, and in the *Canadian Periodical Index*.

The past two decades have witnessed fascinating and controversial advances in the biological sciences. One may think, for instance, of methods for analyzing the basic molecular units of heredity; of proposals and clarifications of the appropriate methods of classifying organisms; of exciting new ideas about the nature of the fossil record and their implications for the elucidation of evolutionary mechanisms; and of ways in which the biological study of behavior has been extended, theoretically and experimentally, and of supposed implications for humankind. Some instances of recent work of this kind are the treatments of universal grammar, pragmatics, conceptions of possibility, theories and mathematical truth in the history of philosophy, formalization of scientific theories, or logical structure in quantum mechanics.
