THE ROSS ARCHIVES

An annotated catalogue of the personal correspondence, manuscripts and newspaper cuttings relevant to the history science and tropical medicine amassed by Ronald Ross, FRS, is to be published in the Spring. The letters, which make up over half this collection, include correspondence with Sir Patrick Manson, FRS, Prof. George Nuttall, FRS, Alphonse Laveran, Gen. W. C. Gorgas, Ramsay MacDonald, Sir Henry Rider Haggard, and Sir Arthur Conan Doyle.

Containing nearly 20,000 entries and with indexes, the catalogue will be available only on microfiche, at £35 a set.
