The *Canadian Journal of Law and Society* (CJLS/RCDS) seeks to promote and publish original research on law and normative orders understood as social phenomena. The Journal is interdisciplinary in scope, calling for a variety of perspectives and methods. Founded in 1985, CJLS/RCDS was initially based at University of Calgary's Research Unit for Socio-Legal Studies. Since 1990, the Journal is affiliated with the Canadian Law and Society Association (www.acds-clsa.org). The same year, the Journal was transferred to University of Quebec in Montreal where it has been edited and published ever since. CJLS/RCDS became biannual beginning with Volume 7 (1992), certain issues being thematic. CJLS/RCDS acknowledges the support of the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada and the Département des sciences juridiques of University of Quebec in Montreal.

La *Revue Canadienne Droit et Société* (RCDS/CJLS) vise à promouvoir la publication de recherches inédites portant sur le droit et les ordres normatifs, entendus comme phénomènes sociaux. Elle est interdisciplinaire, faisant appel aux diverses perspectives et méthodes d'analyse du droit et de la normativité. Créée en 1985 et éditée d'abord à l'Université de Calgary, au Research Unit for Socio-Legal Studies, la Revue fut rattachée, en 1990, à l'Association Canadienne Droit et Société (www.acds-clsa.org). La même année, elle fut transférée à l'Université du Québec à Montréal où elle est éditée et publiée depuis. À partir du Volume 7 (1992), le rythme de publication passa à deux numéros par an, dont régulièrement des numéros thématiques. La RCDS/CJLS dispose de l'appui du Conseil de recherches en sciences humaines du Canada et du Département des sciences juridiques de l'Université du Québec à Montréal.
