## **Bustards: A Guide to Their Ecology and Conservation**

International Council for Bird Preservation in association with the Dubai Wildlife Research Centre, 1984, £2-50, including postage and packing, from ICBP, 219c Huntingdon Road, Cambridge CB3 0DL, UK

This authoritative account of the world's 22 bustard species is lavishly illustrated and provides a concise introduction to all aspects of bustard behaviour, ecology, taxonomy and conservation. A large part of the text is devoted to individual treatments of each species. Some currently number fewer than 1000 individuals, but the status of most is still largely a matter of conjecture since so little is known about them. The booklet is being used to generate a greater interest in bustards, especially in East Africa where 1200 copies are being distributed free to wildlife clubs in schools and colleges. Proceeds from sales in Europe will be used entirely for bustard conservation work.
