For serial publications of the great academies:

Abh. Akad. ... [followed by name of city, e.g. Berlin, Munich, etc.] = *Abhandlungen der ... [preussischen, bayerischen, etc.] Akademie der Wissenschaften, philosophischhistorische Klasse*.

Similarly for *Mémoires*, *Proceedings*, *Rendiconti*, *Sitzungsberichte*, etc., the abridged form is always understood as referring to the series covering philosophy and the humanities where several classes or sections exist in a single academy. E.g.:
