It is published bimonthly, one volume per year, six issues per year beginning in January.

Membership is \$75 per year, student affiliate membership \$30, which includes receipt of *Weed Science*, *Weed Technology*, and *WSSA Newsletter*. Dues should be sent to WSSA, 810 East 10th Street, Lawrence, KS 66044-8897 not later than December 1 of each year. Membership in the society is on a calendar-year basis only.
