## THE PARABLES OF CHRIST

WITH NOTES FOR PREACHING  
AND MEDITATION

Fundamental truths are always capable of simple enunciation, and He who supremely understood the human understanding and the human heart chose to enshrine almost all His basic teachings in the setting of parables. These parables and their messages constitute today a very substantial part of the richest treasure, not only of Christian believers, but of the whole human race. They express ideals and convey lessons without which it is almost universally conceded man and his society must vanish from the earth.

With incomparable beauty, simplicity and directness, all Christian doctrines develop from the parables, and as a rule each doctrine is shown, so to speak, *in action*—becomes alive. From Christ's own lips we thus learn not only what to believe, but how we must *live* our belief.

The first part of this book consists of a general introduction to the parables as a whole. The second part deals with each parable in detail, analysing the context and setting, the image or illustration, the application and teaching illustrated, and the lessons that follow.
