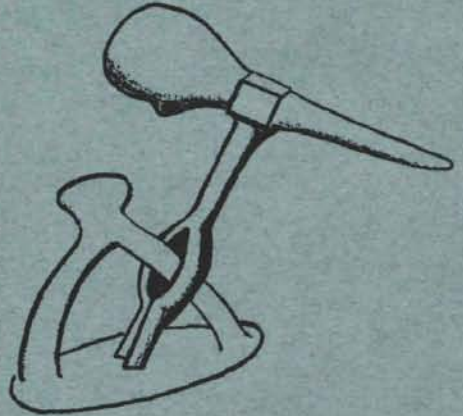

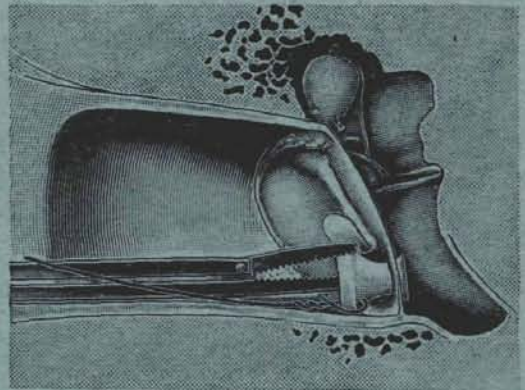
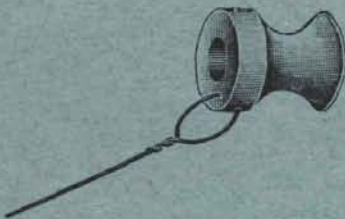


Sultana's Stainless Steel Spring Middle Ear Prosthesis, 4 mm. long
