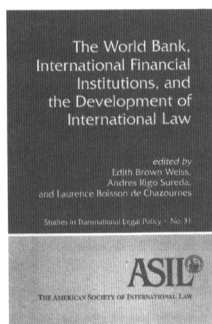
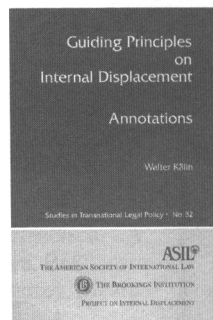
Guiding Principles on Internal Displacement: Annotations
